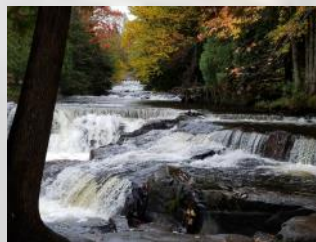
It's time to start planning runs for next year. A sign-up sheet will be circulated starting with the December meeting.
