December 3, 2019

Call to Order: President Don VandenAvond called the meeting to order at 8:05 PM at Wally's Spot, Green Bay, WI with 63 members in attendance.

Approval of November Minutes as posted on website: President VandenAvond explained that there was an error in the November minutes, the error indicated that the board position was a 3-year commitment, correction of 1-year commitment was made. President VandenAvond then called for a motion to approve the corrected minutes as posted on the website, a motion was made by Conrad Sutek and seconded by Fred Bartman, motion approved.

Treasurer Report: President VandenAvond explained the monthly treasurer report was not available and will be presented at the January meeting. Membership is currently 191 paid members and 4 honorary members. Both December and January treasurer reports will be approved the January meeting, members approved of this explanation.


