## April 6, 2021

## Call to Order:

- After washing your car, the brakes can seize up if you just let the car sit with moisture in the brake pads and on the rotors. Be sure to drive the car for a bit to heat/dry the brakes to eliminate the moisture.

June 6 — The Fond du Lac Corvette Club is having its annual drive around Lake Winnebago with a stop at Waverly Beach. Registration 7:00—8:45 am in the Forest Mall Parking Lot. There is no fee, but donations will be accepted to benefit a food pantry.
