Corvettes of the Bay process of Nominations and Elections: September 2024 Bylaws of the Corvettes of the Bay, Inc.

Article IV Members,

Section 4.13 Nominations

A nominating committee appointed by the President at the September Members' Meeting shall seek interested and qualified individuals willing to serve as Officers and Directors. The Committee shall report its nominations at the October Monthly Members Meeting.

Additional nominations may be made by a Member of the Corporation at the October Members Meeting provided prior consent of the nominee has been secured. A Ballot listing all nominations shall be included in the October Monthly Newsletter.

Article V, Board of Directors,

Section 5.01 Authority of Directors

The Board of Directors is the policy-making body responsible for the business and affairs of the Corporation and may exercise all the powers and authority granted by law in conjunction with the Articles of Incorporation and these Bylaws.

Section 5.02 Number, Selection and Tenure

The Board of Directors shall consist of seven (7) members who include the Club Officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer), the Immediate Past President of the Corporation and two individuals elected by and from the Membership at large. If the Past President is already a Member of the Board of Directors due to his or her position as a current Officer of the Corporation, or is no longer an active member, then the third Director position will be filled by election of a member at large. Directors elected from the Membership at large will serve for a one-year term and may seek reappointment for a term not to exceed three (3) consecutive years. After one year off, an individual may seek reelection to the Board of Directors.

Vacancies existing by reason of resignation, death, incapacity or removal before the expiration of his/her term shall be filled by a majority vote of the remaining Directors. In the event of a tie, the President shall choose the succeeding Director. A Director elected to fill the vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of that Director's predecessor in Office.
