A Silver Lining Leads to a Silver Corvette!

Some people are always searching for a silver lining, Vicki Blahnik's search ended with a silver Corvette. Vicki remembers, "It all started when my father purchased a brand new 1966 Plymouth Fury III Silver Special right off the showroom floor in Clintonville, WI." Cherished childhood memories of seeing her family's Silver Special glistening under the streetlights ignited a lifelong passion. Vicki dreamed of having a silver car, a dream that finally came true in September 2022. Vicki and her husband Scott tracked down this 1999 Sebring Silver Corvette Convertible in Michigan. You might say it was served up on a "silver platter." Its original owner had developed back trouble and was forced to sell.

As devoted Corvettes of the Bay members, Vicki and Scott own 1 of only 3,510 Corvettes adorned in Sebring Silver in 1999 out of a total production run of 33,270. In fact, the Blahnik's Corvette fits into a slim two-year window for the color Sebring Silver which was only offered in 1999 and 2000 after Chevrolet retired Sebring Silver Metallic as an official color in 1998.

The Sebring Silver paint isn't all that shines on this Corvette. Born with a 5.7 Liter LS1 engine with 345 horsepower, this LS1 has been heavily modified to send a power-packed 420 horsepower to the rear wheels. All that excitement exits through Borla stainless steel exhaust giving this chariot a surly soundtrack as it dips below 5 seconds on a 0 to 60 run while pushing the top end well past the factory specification of 172 mph!

As fast as this C-5 Convertible may be, sometimes it pays to go slow. By taking years to find just the right Sebring Silver Corvette, Vicki and Scott Blahnik turned silver into gold!
